Qualification Criteria

Application Deadline is 5:00 p.m., March 30, 2021.

- Hawaii resident with proof of U.S. citizenship-Scholarship recipients must provide proof of U.S. citizenship, such as a birth certificate, U.S. Passport, U.S. Certificate of Citizenship, or U.S. Naturalization Certificate.
- Graduating from a Hawaii public high school: Applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better and must have a certified official school transcript mailed by the school to the Rotary Club of Honolulu at the address below. Transcripts must be received before March 30, 2021.
- State of Hawai'i College or University: Applicant must have applied to or be currently attending a 4 year degree-granting program of study, or registered in a baccalaureate program of study at a public or private college or university in Hawai'i, accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) in the State of Hawai'i.
- Essay: Applicant should submit a 300 word essay on obstacles they have overcome and on how this scholarship would make a difference in their life going forward.
- Copy of the first two pages of parent's 2019 Federal Tax form 1040 or copy of SAR Report. Please cover with black ink any Social Security Numbers.
- Copy of your 2020 FAFSA application form.
