

COVID-19 Policy

According to the Center for Disease Control and Hawaii's Department of Human Services (DHS) COVID-19 guidelines we ask that parents/guardians follow these requests to ensure the safety of staff and students:

- Face masks must be worn when picking up and dropping off child(ren). Children must also be wearing a face mask. Our supply of disposable masks are limited and we will only be giving them out when necessary.
- Practice six-foot distancing from others who are not in your household during pick-up and drop-off times. We also encourage bringing your own pen to use during these times.
- We ask that one person picks-up and drops-off the child(ren) and if there are others accompanying you to have them wait out front or in the car. We will be logging all visitors in accordance with Hawaii's DHS guidelines in case of contact tracing.
- If your child is feeling sick or developing flu-like symptoms, please keep them at home. We will be doing temperature checks of each child during drop-off. If your child has a temperature of at least 99°F, they will be asked to go home.
- If your child starts to feel sick or develop flu-like symptoms during the day, we will call the emergency contact(s) for immediate pick-up. If there is an emergency and 911 has been called, we will notify the emergency contact(s).
- If anyone in your household or your child has COVID-19 or COVID-19 symptoms, please let us know and quarantine for 14-days.

How SEP is Being COVID-19 Safe

1. Daily temperature checks (99°F and up will not be able to do program for the day).
2. Required use of masks for staff and encouraged use of masks for children.
3. 10 people max per group (9 kids, 1 leader). Leader will stay with the same group of kids throughout the day.
4. Sanitizing high touch points throughout the day (e.g. door handles).
5. Sanitizing and wiping down supplies/areas after use (e.g. tables, paintbrushes, gym equipment).
6. Social distancing between kids by using tapes and signs as a visual and requiring masks to be worn when social distancing is difficult.
7. Handwashing after activities that involve touching a lot of supplies.
8. Bring your own water bottle. We will have a designated area for water bottles.
9. Bring a bag/backpack to put finished crafts in.
